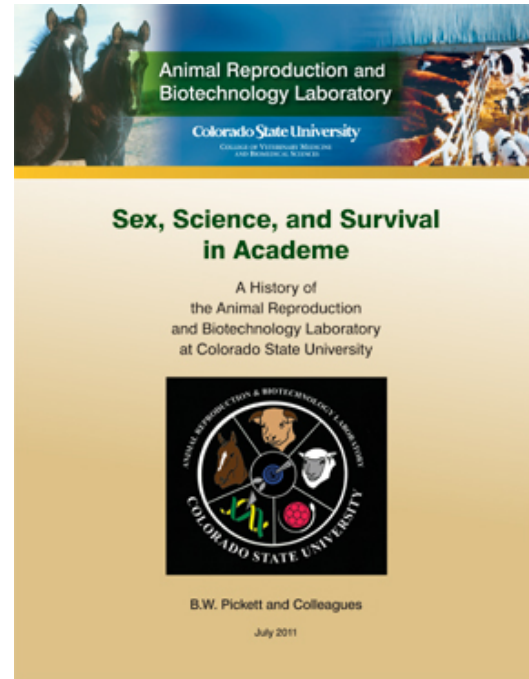


# Sex, Science, and Survival in Academe: A History of the Animal Reproduction and Biotechnology Laboratory at Colorado State University
